To Learn (program) a new remote:

Press — (Scroll Down) to scroll down to Upgrade All.

User Tips



Each button on the remote corresponds to its dedicated input on the soundbar. To access a specific input, simply select the corresponding button on the remote.

Bluetooth Pairing an additional device while on the Bluetooth input: Push & Hold the Bluetooth button on the remote for 4 seconds. The soundbar will emit a tone confirming that the broadcast feature is now active and a new device can now be paired. Note! Once the tone is emitted, the original pairing will be cancelled along with the media stream.
